### Vision/Mission

The aim of the Language Resource Center is to allow users to interact independently with a range of materials, promoting a meaningful and authentic experience of language acquisition as a living process. The Language Resource Center at an Najah University is therefore designed to be an organic and welcoming environment so that learners can engage with the target language in a relaxed and natural setting.

### Methodology

Traditionally, languages have been taught with the instructor being the source of the learner's language experience. The instructor therefore becomes a barrier between the learner and the language itself. The Language Resource Center however focuses on learners being able to directly experience the language in a meaningful and communicative way, with the instructor being there to guide students by providing linguistic and cultural expertise.

The instructors at the Learning Resource Center provide language learners with real sources in the foreign language matched to the learner's capabilities, interests and needs; contextualize these sources; and allow opportunities for learners to respond to the materials, promoting meaningful communication in the target language.

### Public

Learners can enroll in courses designed to focus their exposure to the target language, as well as simply drop in to make use of resources or to talk to staff. Students and university staff can use the resources to study independently as well as enroll on the programs on offer. Individuals from outside the university can also make use of the resources for specific purposes.



### Programs

The Language Resource Center offers courses for English, German, French, Spanish, and Turkish ... at all levels for individuals or small groups, for personal and professional purposes.

Our intensive Language program duration is **16 weeks**, starting and ending with the semester on the university calendar.
